Who we are

Christian volunteers lay and clergy, from local churches called to minister to the sick, infirmed, elderly, their families, and hospital staff. Chaplains currently represent 40 local churches.

We Provide Training

Initial Training – Orientation class covering: how to represent God in the hospital, visiting patients – correct procedures, safety and confidentiality requirement, prayer principles, and active listening. New chaplains are assigned a mentor who leads the chaplain in the correct procedures, the dos and don'ts for hospital visiting.

<u>Advanced Training</u> – Special speakers at our monthly meetings that cover various topics such as special patients, trauma, end of life decisions, grief, loss crisis, etc.

<u>Mentor Training</u> – Topics include equipping new chaplains, goals for new chaplains, and Jesus the perfect mentor.

Commitment to Visiting

Spend a minimum of two hours per week visiting and offering prayers for patients, family member, and staff.

We Visit

Nursing homes, assisted living centers, and seven local hospitals; Centennial Hills, Desert Springs, North Vista, Spring Valley, Summerlin, Valley and UMC.

Other

We conduct a worship service at the UMC Chapel every Sunday form 2-3pm. We also have Hope Chaplains on-call to answer emergency calls at our seven hospitals.

Literature We Distribute

The Hope Chaplaincy provides Bibles (only as requested), brochures, and Our Daily Bread magazine. All other literature is non-denominational and non-confrontational. Literature is selected to encourage patients and residents regardless of their faith.

H.O.P.E. Chaplain Meetings

A regular monthly meeting is held every third Saturday from 10am to noon at the UMC Delta Point building. The meeting purpose is to promote unity fellowship, advance training and testimonies, as well as keeping chaplains abreast of the business activities of the Chaplaincy.
